RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRIES

Entries close May 7, 2010. Entries postmarked after the closing date will be considered post entries and will be subject to a \$40 late fee. Entries are considered complete when the following items are received: 1) signed open check for entries, 2) completed and signed entry blank, 3) copy of negative coggins and 4) copy of all rider/owner/trainer membership cards.

STALLS

Stall Reservations close May 7, 2010. Stalls reserved after the closing date will be subject to a \$15 late fee. Horse and tack stalls available at \$135 per stall. Payment for stalls ordered must accompany stall reservation request. Stalls are approximately 9' x 9', either permanent wood or temporary vinyl, all with doors. Stalls will be available on Tuesday @ noon and must be vacated by 9:00 a.m. Monday. All horses showing out of trailer will be charged a \$25 grounds fee. Stall fees are non-refundable after the closing date.

SCRATCHES.

Refund of entries: In case of horses being entered and not exhibited, the entry fee will be forfeited. If a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to being shown in any class, the entry fee will be refunded by mail upon receipt of veterinarian's certificate. An office processing fee of \$20 plus and office fee of \$15 per legitimately excused animal will be deducted from the refund. All veterinary certificates to be considered must be in the hands of show management prior to the start of the Show. Once the show has started there are no refunds on entry or nominating fees unless the official show veterinarian examines the entry in question and deems it unfit to compete, in which case, full refund of entry and nominating fees occurs less a \$50 Vet Scratch Refund Fee. No refunds on entries that choose to scratch due to inclement weather. A fee of \$75 will be charged for returned checks.

COGGINS

A negative Coggins dated within the last 12 months is required for all horses for admittance to the show grounds. Please send a copy with entries.

SCHOOLING

Schooling over a course of jumps will be available in each hunter rings on the day prior to showing, starting 12 noon and ending 6:00 pm, pending weather. Schooling fee: \$20 per horse. An EMT will be provided on grounds during schooling hours. All riders mounted on a horse and jumping must wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmet. Pending weather, FLATTING in the show rings only during the morning hours.

ARENA FOOTING and MEASUREMENTS

All footing in all competition and warm up areas is limestone sand, with dimensions as follows: Jumper Ring: 150' x 300', warm up 100' x 200'; Hunter Rings: 125' x 300', warm up 100' x 200' each.

POLING

Manual poling and use of bamboo offset are prohibited at all times while on the grounds. Exhibitors in violation will forfeit all entry fees for that showing day or day afterwards.

PRIZE MONEY

Prize Money will be credited to entry one hour after the completion of each class. Prize monies in excess of balances due will be credited and mailed to owner of record, unless otherwise directed, within 30 days after the completion of the show. All owners whose horses are competing for prize money must have a Federal Tax ID number or social security number on file with the show office prior to issuing of numbers.

CREDENTIALS

The following horse/rider/owner/trainer credentials must be presented to show secretary prior to numbers being issued: (1) Pony/Junior Hunter measurement cards, (2) USEF/USHJA membership cards for O/R/T, (3) USEF Horse ID number or USEF recording number (4) ASPCA Maclay membership number (if applicable), (5) FED ID or SOC SEC number for owner of each horse competing for prize money.

SHARPS CONTAINERS

Placed throughout barns for the disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. Their use is mandatory. Improper disposal of these objects will be subject to a fine.

MANAGEMENT

The Blue Rock Horse Show and Oakleigh, Inc. will not be responsible in any way for loss, or damage to any person, animal, property or equipment, and each exhibitor shall assume all liability and hold harmless the Blue Rock Horse Show and Oakleigh, Inc. for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal, property, or equipment that may be caused by any horse or pony entered by them or due to the carelessness or negligence of the person or persons in charge of such horse or pony, or any of their subordinates or superiors. Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally and to cancel any entry, disqualify exhibitor(s), prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel awards of prizes without claims for damages. Divisions may be combined or cancelled if insufficient entries warrant. Management reserves the right to amend the Tentative Time Schedule if necessary.

CAMPERS

Camper sites are available at a fee of \$140/camper. Please include reservation on the entry blank. Camp sites include water and one 20 amp outlet.

HUNTER COURSES

Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as: brush, wall, in and out, oxer, post and rail, aiken, and panels. In some cases a mandatory line may restrict the area of the courtesy circle. Handy Hunter Course will be the second over fence class in each division.

CHAMPIONSHIP AND RESERVE

Hunters: Champion and Reserve title will be awarded to two of the four horses acquiring the most points over fences in each hunter section. In addition to these points, only these four horses will receive full points for under saddle classes. Points to determine awards as follows: 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, ½; Model Class to count ½. Jumpers: Champion and Reserve title awarded to the two horses that have acquired the most points in each Jumper section except sections with less than 3 classes/division. In the event of a tie, the award will be made jointly. Prize Money awarded in each Jumper Section to count toward their respective USEF Horse of the Year Awards. Points to determine awards as follows: 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, ½.

FEED/BEDDING

Hay, grain and bedding may be purchased on the show grounds. Please send or fax orders in advance to Blue Rock Horse Show on the enclosed form (Page 27).

JUMPER COURSES

Courses in the jumper section may consist of any combination of the following: brush, gates, oxers, post and rails, Liverpool, wall, panels, and coops. Time-allowed is based on 382 yards per minute.

JUMPER NOMINATION & SPECS

To be eligible for the Jumper Divisions (Hopeful, Training, Schooling, Pony, Children's, and Adult Jumper excluded), horses must be nominated and the nominating fee of \$125 paid by the closing date of entries. Horse nominated after that date must pay a nominating fee of \$140. Once a horse is nominated he becomes eligible to compete in any jumper class for which it is eligible, upon payment of the showing fee for said class. All horses showing in any jumper classes which offer prize money must be recorded with the USEF. Attire for daytime classes may include polo shirts with collars. Ties for other than first place will be decided by the time taken in the first round. DECLARATIONS DUE IN SHOW OFFICE BY 5PM THE DAY PRECEDING ALL JUMPER CLASSES UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES

GR 301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minor who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid drivers license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

HELMETS

See USEF Rulebook GR318: It is compulsory for riders in all Hunter, Jumper, and Hunt Seat Equitation classes, and Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. Helmets must be properly fitted with harness secured. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT













By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultler, Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at regular competitions, eventing competitions at the preliminary level or above and combined driving competitions at the advanced level, dressage, reining and vaulting competitions and endurance rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at regular competitions, eventing competitions, dressage competitions, reining competitions, and combined driving competitions upon payment of a \$30 non-member registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule: 1) Lead-line; 2) Exhibitions; 3) Games and Races; 4) Classes for 4-H members; 5) Walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining competitions; 8) Opportunity classes.

9) Citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

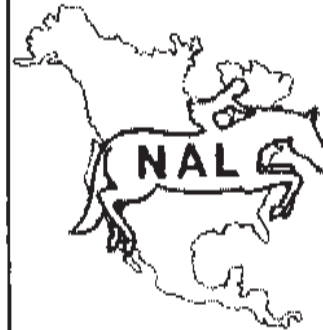
